

Q: WHEN DO I NEED TO RESERVE TEXAS RITAS SERVICES? A: Within the same month you book your venue, you should email info@texasritas.com with the following information to tentatively reserve Texas Ritas services.

1. *Date / Hall name rented /Type of event (subject line)*
2. *Contact Name & Phone Number*

Q. DO YOU REQUIRE ANY DEPOSIT? A. No deposit is required. You will need to make sure you finalize a contract to return with the payment two weeks before your Event/ Wedding date.

Q: WHEN DO I NEED TO FINALIZE THE BAR SERVICES? A: 45 days before your Wedding / Event Date. At that time, you will need to provide your total number of guests (with children), the number of adult drinkers, the specific types, and quantities of each alcoholic beverage you plan to bring for us to serve, ceremony time, and the time you would like the bar opened and closed.

Q. CAN ADDITIONAL BAR SERVING TIME BE PURCHASED? A. No extra time may be purchased. Texas Ritas serves for a maximum of six hours to ensure the safety of your guests upon leaving the wedding celebration.

Q. DO YOU HAVE RULES RELATING TO THE TYPES OF ALCOHOL THAT WE CAN SERVE AND RULES RELATING TO THE SERVING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES? A. Yes, please review all of our rules and pricing online at www.texasritas.com.

Q. HOW MANY BARTENDERS DO I NEED FOR MY EVENT? A. The number of Bartenders depends on the type of event you're having, the number of drinking guests, and the quantities and types of all the alcoholic beverages you plan to bring for us to serve.

If you plan to serve beer, wine, and frozen margaritas you will need:

- Weddings /Events - 1 BARTENDER = 0 to 125 Guests *2 BARTENDERS = 125 to 250 Guests *3 BARTENDERS = 250 to 450 Guests
- Fraternity/ Sorority/ Quinceanera (Sweet15) Events = *2 BARTENDERS = 0 to 200 GUEST * 3 BARTENDERS = 201 to 450 Guest

If you plan to serve beer, wine, and liquor for mixed drinks you will need:

- Weddings /Events -1 BARTENDER = 0 to 85 Guests *2 BARTENDERS = 86 to 175 Guests *3 BARTENDERS = 176 to 325 Guests
- Fraternity/ Sorority/ Quinceanera (Sweet 15) Events = *2 BARTENDERS = 0 to 200 GUEST * 3 BARTENDERS = 201 to 450 Guest

Q. HOW MANY MARGARITA MACHINES DO I NEED FOR MY NUMBER OF GUEST?

A. The number of margarita machines depends on your number of guests and types of other beverages you plan to serve. One margarita machine can serve 25 frozen drinks at one time, and then it takes 20 minutes to refreeze.

- 125 Guests, you would need one margarita machine & two mixes
- 126- 250 Guests, you would need two margarita machines & 4 mixes
- 251-375 Guests, you would need three margarita machines & 6 mixes

Q. WILL TEXAS RITAS ASSIST IN PROVIDING A BAR PACKAGE AND SETUP FOR THE BAR?

A. Yes, we can create a bar package that fits your exact needs. Our customized bar package includes 2 hours of setup, coolers for chilling all your bar drinks, keg containers (you bring actual kegs), domestic foot pump taps with three pour spouts, ice, plastic beer cups, plastic wine cups, plastic champagne flutes, and bar napkins. A customized quote can be emailed 60 days before your event date. The client would be responsible for supplying all the drink options.

Q. WILL THE BARTENDER PUT OUT A TIP JAR? A. Yes, the bartender will put out a tip jar unless you prepay \$95 Gratuity (cash) to the bartender before the bar opening. IF YOU PREPAY A TIP, the bartender will not put out a tip jar or ask for tips, but guests may still want to tip the bartender for an EXcellent Job done (even when the bartender has informed them that the clients have prepaid gratuity). *All Business, Fraternity, Sorority, Children's, and Quinceanera Events, will be required to prepay \$95 gratuity per bartender, at the time of booking.

*All Events that fall on or around (two days before or two days after) a holiday (New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, and New Year's Eve), will be required to prepay \$125 gratuity per bartender, at the time of booking.
